Competent / Skilled Person Electrical Low Voltage Course HTM 06-02 is aimed at the NHS and all other Low Voltage electrical systems

To assist your organisation's electrical staff in gaining the knowledge required to carry out Competent Person duties and responsibilities in order to achieve compliance with the requirements of the Electricity at Work Regulations 1989 and HTM Policy 06-02 for Low Voltage HTM 06-02.

The course is based on the content of HSG 85 Electricity at Work Safe Working Practices and the specific requirements of Health Technical Memorandum 06-02 Electrical Safety Guidance for Low Voltage Systems fulfilling the requirements of Appendix 7 of HTM 06-02.
