- * Introduction to basic electrical formula i.e. V=IR and transposition I= V/R and R=V/I
- * Regulations, policies and procedures
- * Need for PPE
- * Construction of different types of cable
- * Cable Preparation for low voltage cables
- * Cable Preparation for high voltage 11kv cables
- * Termination of a single phase cut out
- * Termination of a three phase cut out
- * Tests at the low voltage service position i.e. phase rotation observation, polarity, voltage and earth loop impedance measurement to assist the cable jointer
 - * Insulated tools and equipment
 - * Safe use and care of Liquid Petroleum Gas Equipment



- * Abrasion of sheaths
- * Fit Joint Shells
- * Mix and Pour Resin Safely

- * Preparation of XLPE, PVC and awareness of Paper Insulated Lead Cable (only if example pilc cable sourced by sponsor / candidate)
 - * Preparation of jointing materials
 - * Preparation of cut outs single phase and three phase

 - * Correct use of tools
